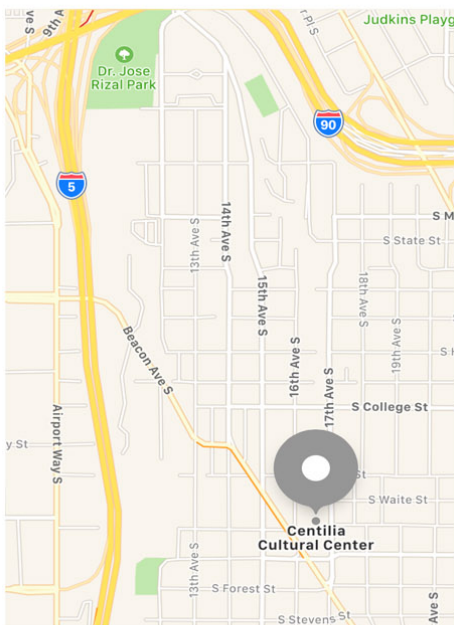
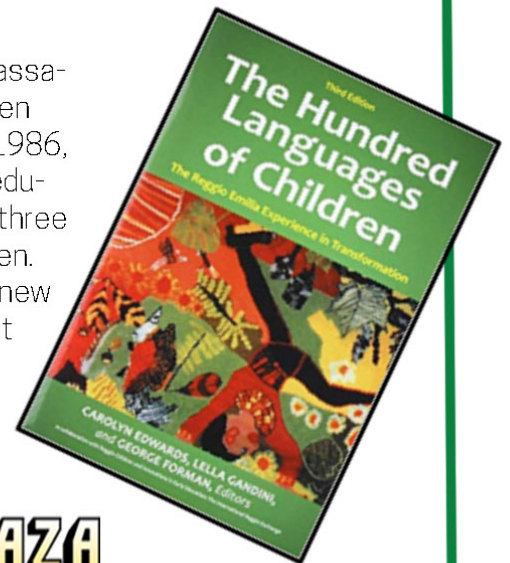
With George Forman



Imagine sitting with colleagues watching a video clip of your children with a shared intention of discovering what the children are thinking while encountering and being changed by each other's perspective. George Forman provides a day immersed in the tiny details present in video recordings—the source of deep practice.

George E. Forman, Ph.D., is Emeritus Professor at the University of Massachusetts, Amherst and President of Videatives, Inc. George has written *The Child's Construction of Knowledge and Constructive Play*. Since 1986, George has worked with the city of Reggio Emilia, Italy, to bring their educational philosophy to prominence in the United States by producing three documentary videos and co-editing *The Hundred Languages of Children*. Upon retirement in 2003, he cofounded Videatives, Inc. to distribute new digital formats to early childhood professionals to help them see what children know, so they can better support their learning.
